# Shared Governance

The Shared Governance positions include such committees as the University wide Promotions committee, the University Forum, and the University Curriculum Committee. This info is usually presented at departmental meetings in February and each department selects candidates to run for the positions and notifies the APSCUF office. Diana prepares the ballots based on information provided by the departments.

All full-time faculty are eligible to run for Shared Governance positions, regardless of APSCUF membership. **If you are interested in running for a position, please be sure you will not have a teaching assignment or be on sabbatical during the known scheduled meeting times of any of the committees. It is a 2 year term.**
