



THE IMPORTANCE OF THE 2020 ELECTION ✓

All 203 of our PA State House seats and 25 of our PA Senate seats will be up in 2020. We will look to build on our 2018 endorsement success and push to have **MORE THAN 50% OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY BE APSCUF-ENDORSED**. The stakes will be high in 2020, with elected officials deciding the following in 2021 and 2022:

- State House and Senate members elected/re-elected in 2020 will vote on legislation drawing the **NEW LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS** for 2022 that will be in place for a decade.
- State House and Senate members elected/re-elected 2020 have a strong likelihood of voting on possible recommendations the **PUBLIC HIGHER EDUCATION FUNDING COMMISSION** proposes.
- State House and Senate members elected/re-elected in 2020 will be tasked with **FUNDING STATE SYSTEM UNIVERSITIES** for the next two years.

APSCUF's Committee for Action through Politics (APSCUF/CAP) is the political voice for APSCUF faculty and coaches. Since its inception in 1981, CAP has assisted faculty and coaches in making informed political decisions. CAP is a nonpartisan organization that supports candidates who will advocate for APSCUF's goals and priorities.
