

THE IMPORTANCE OF THE 2020 ELECTION

All 203 of our PA State House seats and 25 of our PA Senate seats will be up in 2020. **THE STAKES WILL BE HIGH** in 2020, with elected officials deciding the following in 2021 and 2022:

- State House and Senate members elected/re-elected in 2020 will vote on legislation drawing the **NEW LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS** for 2022 that will be in place for a decade.
- State House and Senate members elected/re-elected 2020 have a strong likelihood of voting on possible recommendations the **PUBLIC HIGHER EDUCATION FUNDING COMMISSION** proposes.
- State House and Senate members elected/re-elected in 2020 will be tasked with **FUNDING STATE SYSTEM UNIVERSITIES** for the next two years.

OTHER IMPORTANT DEADLINES IN PENNSYLVANIA:

OCT. 19: Last day to REGISTER before the November election

OCT. 27: Last day to apply for a mail-in or civilian absentee ballot

NOV. 3: Last day for County Boards of Elections to receive voted mail-in and civilian absentee ballots (must be post-marked by 8 p.m.)

NOV. 3: GENERAL ELECTION Polls are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
